4e. Traffic Concerns – Cypress Street between Trask Avenue and Garden Grove

Commissioner Kadi Kiisk-Mohr recused herself for this item as she is the resident who brought it to the Commission.

The staff report dated March 05, 2019 was introduced to consider a request to install a physical barrier on Cypress Street south of Central Avenue to prohibit through traffic.

Staff received a petition from a resident requesting the City to consider installing a physical barrier on Cypress Street to prevent through traffic. A neighborhood meeting was held on December 6, 2018 to discuss the requested closure. The residents agreed that speeding is an issue but the majority were not in favor of the physical barrier.

The Police Department assigned motor officers to enforce the speed limit on Cypress Street and the speed radar trailer has been placed multiple times. Based on the feedback from the motor officers, they do not feel that there is a speeding issue on Cypress Street.

It was moved and seconded to accept staff's recommendation to NOT approve the request to install a physical barrier on Cypress Street south of Central Avenue; and approve staff's recommendation to install a double yellow centerline, four inch white edge-line, and a series 25mph pavement legends on Cypress Street between Trask Avenue and Garden Grove Boulevard.

- Lampson/Haster concern taking a long time to complete. Poles are taking a long time to get delivered. Approximately 4 months to get delivered.

MATTERS FROM STAFF:

- Brookhurst Street/Woodbury Street – Does not meet the minimum requirement of five (5) points.
- Newland Street /Trask Avenue – Grant received for left turn phasing
- Roxey Street /Trask Avenue – Grant received for new traffic signal

Federal paper work is being completed for these as well as a grant was received to replace all 24 Radar Feedback signs along pedestrian signals.
